Procurement Projects in Flight

ERP Professional Services



STATUS: SERVICE DEVELOPMENT

This agreement will offer a wide array of ERP professional services to support members with platform implementations and ongoing platform maintenance. There are 13 participating members and the estimated posting period is October 2024.

STATUS: SERVICE DEVELOPMENT

The current contract with <u>Netagen</u> will expire January 2025. There are seven participating members and the estimated award for v2 is early 2025.

STATUS: NEGOTIATIONS

We have successfully secured an Enterprise level agreement directly with AWS. We are now working towards establishing an Enterprise Discount Program to negotiate a consortium considerate discount plan.

STATUS: EVALUATIONS

Cybera has been working collaboratively with BCNET, OECM & ISI for an electronic research administration system to replace the ROMEO platform. This has been a five stage evaluation process, with an expected award recommendation in December 2024. There are 14 participating members from across the country, with four from Alberta.



New Procurement Projects Approved for 25/26

AudioVisual Hardware v2

ShareIT is moving forward with the second version of our Audiovisual Hardware agreement, set to launch in December 2024. We will be issuing a call for participation in the RFx working group soon. This new agreement will provide enhanced services, and we encourage active involvement from all interested parties. Further details will be shared soon.

Enterprise Content Management (ECM)

Project is targeted to initiate in April 2025

The ECM project aims to streamline document management and improve collaboration across the organization. By implementing advanced tools for content creation, storage, and retrieval, ShareIT members will benefit from enhanced efficiency, reduced redundancy, and better compliance with regulatory standards. This initiative will empower teams to access critical information easily, fostering a more productive work environment.

Uninterruptible Power Supply (UPS)

Project is targeted to initiate in January 2025

The UPS project is designed to ensure that ShareIT members experience uninterrupted access to vital systems and data. By upgrading power management infrastructure, members will experience enhanced system reliability and minimize downtime during power outages. This initiative will provide peace of mind, knowing that critical operations can continue seamlessly, thereby supporting overall productivity and service continuity.

Qualitative Data Analysis

Project is targeted to initiate in summer 2025. Market analysis review currently underway.

The Qualitative Data Analysis project has been greenlit for further exploration by the ShareIT team. This initiative aims to assess and refine our members' capabilities in analyzing non-numerical data, which can provide valuable insights into student and administrative behaviors and preferences. By developing a robust offering in this area, ShareIT members can leverage deep qualitative insights to drive informed decision-making and enhance strategic initiatives.

National procurement project recognized by the Canadian Association of University Business Officers

Cybera was recently honored by the Canadian Association of University Business Officers (CAUBO) for its role in developing a collaborative procurement method focused on inter-organizational knowledge sharing. Recognized during the 2024 Quality and Productivity Awards, Cybera and partners BCNET, OECM, and ISI are working to replace the soon-to-be-phased-out ROMEO system. This approach leverages the expertise and purchasing power of 30 post-secondary institutions, ensuring comprehensive requirements and reducing costs. Adobe Express (formerly Adobe Spark) offers two access options for Canadian K-12 users: <u>a free Adobe Express for K-12 Education license</u>, providing access to Adobe Express Premium at no cost, and a paid Creative Cloud for Education license that includes tools like Photoshop and Illustrator. Individual educators in Canada using Google Workspace for Education can create their own Adobe Express accounts and invite students.
